Organization of the workshop

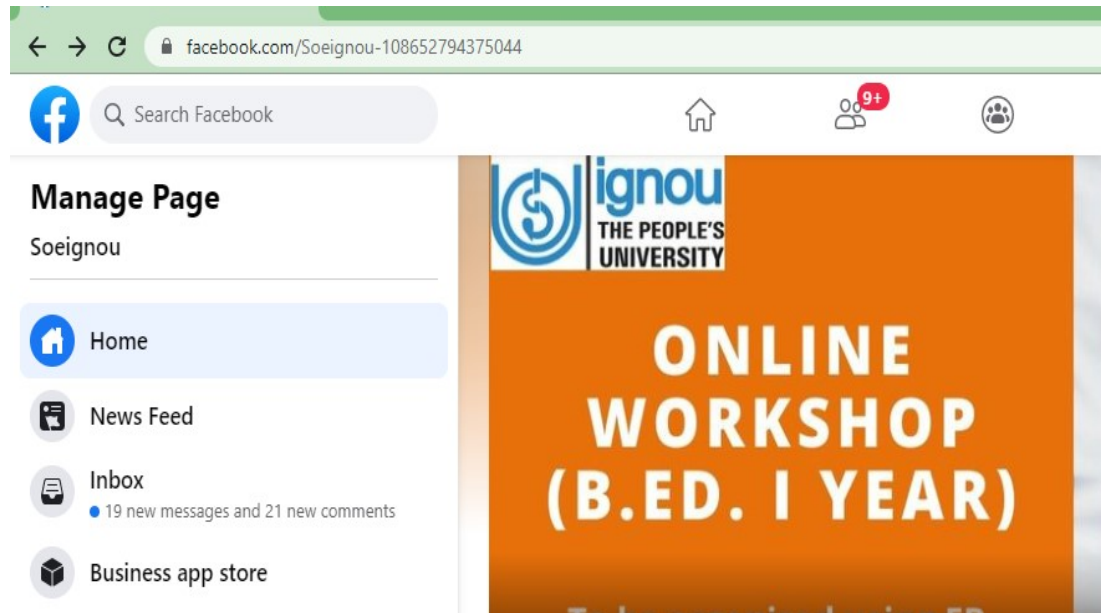
- The online workshop will be of 12 days duration and will be organized at all Programme Study Centers of B.Ed. programme having learners for July, 2019 and/or January, 2020 batch.
- Workshop will start on January 18, 2021 and will end on January 30, 2021. There will no session on January 26, 2021.
- Workshop will be organized in online mode only. No session will be organized in face-to-face situation keeping in mind the present Covid-19 protocols.
- Each day, morning sessions will be organized centrally from IGNOU Headquarters through Facebook live, in which faculty members of SOE will deliver the sessions and all learners are expected to join the sessions.
- Afternoon sessions will be organized by PSCs under the supervision of RC using group conferencing tools like Google MEET.
- Attendance for all the sessions will be maintained and ensured by the PSCs. (For attendance of FB live sessions, learners may be asked to include screen shot of the sessions in their reflective diary with a comment of their name and enrollment no., For attendance in Google MEET session either excel sheet can be generated by add-in in Google MEET or a Google form may be created for every session by PSC and link may be shared during the session to fill before ending the session)
- After completion of the workshop, learners are expected to submit their reports of all activities completed during the workshop, their internship reports and EPC activity reports at PSCs.
- PSCs will evaluate those reports and submit the grades to RC/SED as per existing procedure.
- Each PSC will maintain a WhatsApp group of all participants.
- It is essential to share the Google meet link with concerned RC official as well as with SOE programme coordinators. It is advised that same meeting link can be created by the PSC for all 12 days to avoid any confusion among learners.
- SOE Faculty/RC nodal person will join the sessions being organized by PSCs as per schedule for facilitating learning and monitoring purpose.
- Each PSC will prepare a day wise report including details resource persons taken the sessions, attendance, screen shots of the session and will submit a consolidated report along with attendance to concerned RC after completion of the workshop.
- The PSCs where more learners are there, can make two batches for July, 2019 and January, 2020 separately and each batch will have separate Google MEET ID and resource person.
